Barrier Lake Field Station General Information: Researchers

Accommodation: Researchers are housed in cabin-style duplexes that contain basic amenities, including kitchen supplies (dishes, pots, and pans) and bunk-style beds. Linens (two non-fitted sheets and a blanket) and towels are provided. For longer stays, researchers are expected to wash their own linens. Housekeeping services are not provided after check-in. Upon arrival, staff will conduct an orientation and safety meeting and provide door access codes. Garbage, refundable containers, and recycling (paper, plastic, and metal) must be placed in the bear-proof bins located behind the Main Lodge. Do not leave any garbage on the decks. Please remove all footwear at the entrance of buildings. Vehicles may be parked at the duplex units. Additional parking is available in the large entrance lot.

Pets, outdoor campfires, and camping are not permitted.

Laundry: Laundry machines are located at the east door of the North Shop. The cost is approximately \$2 per wash and \$1 per dry. Machines accept loonies and quarters. Please provide your own laundry detergent.

Internet/Cell: Wireless internet is accessible in most buildings. University of Calgary users can access the network through **airuc-secure**. Researchers from other institutions may access the network via **Eduroam**. A wired computer lab is available in the Science Building. Printing is available upon request. Cell service is available on site.

Lab access/Storage: Lab and storage space are available upon request. All chemicals must be WHMIS-labeled with the associated lab name and properly stored in the wet lab. All stored materials must be clearly labeled. Perishable items are not permitted in storage areas.

Duplex expectations

- Researchers are responsible for keeping the unit clean.
- You will be provided with toilet paper, cleaning supplies, and dish towels at the start of your stay. When supplies run out, it is the researchers' responsibility to purchase.
- No housekeeping is provided during your stay.
- Keep your living and lab space clean. Researchers will be subject to surcharges if kitchen supplies are broken or missing, living spaces are left unclean, and for unreturned equipment.
- It is your responsibility to wash the linens as no further housekeeping will be provided during the stay.
- There is one vacuum cleaner available in unit but must be empty after each use.
- Please let us know if there is an item that is broken and requires fixing or replacement.
